Subject: **Status Report Request – Traffic Signal Timing and Synchronization**

It appears traffic delays through Route 1 have increased significantly. Recent reports (November 17, 2010) indicated that the timing and synchronization of traffic signals have been affected by power fluctuations that occurred in the month of November.

The "Traffic Congestion Alert" further stated that all recalibrations efforts would be completed by Friday, November 19, 2010.

As of November 22, 2010, my office has received numerous constituent complaints indicating no change in the timing and synchronization of traffic signals located throughout Dededo, Upper Tumon, Tamuning and Hagåtña.

I formally request that the Department of Public Works expedite the recalibration of the traffic signals and provide a status report that indicates anticipated completion of this project.
