The Guam State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program (SEEARP)

Overview

The United States of America through President Barrack Obama identified Federal Dollars in the American Re-Investment and Recovery Act (ARRA) for the State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program (SEEARP) to stimulate Guam's economy and to financially assist consumers who replace old appliances with new energy efficient appliances.

Goals and Objectives

The goal of SEEARP is to help residents save energy and to stimulate Guam's economy encouraging island residents to replace used appliances with new ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. The program once implemented by the Guam Energy Office (GEO), is expected to reduce pollution, lower energy bills for those who participate, and ultimately stimulate Guam's economy.

Program Summary

There are several retailers on island who have agreed to participate in the SEEARP where ENERGY STAR appliances can be purchased. The program will be offering rebate vouchers to qualified residents to apply towards the purchase of ENERGY STAR appliances such as freezers, refrigerators, clothes washers, room air conditioners, and split air conditioners. The program intent is to have residents replace their existing models with ENERGY STAR certified appliances.

There are certain terms and conditions that outline who is eligible and what products are ENERGY STAR certified. Participation in SEEARP is limited to individuals residing on Guam and is administered on a first come, first served basis, due to set funding. Applications can be picked up at the Guam Energy Office in Tamuning across from the One Stop Center in the DPW complex. Only qualified applicants may participate in the SEEARP.

A completed application must be submitted to GEO and meet the terms and condition set forth in order to qualify for the program. Incomplete applications will be returned. A completed application can be resubmitted and will be processed in the order received and while funds last. If an application is rejected, funds are not held until an application form is processed.

Qualifying ENERGY STAR Products

Appliances to be purchased must meet certain program requirements and must be purchased from a registered retailer. A list of qualifying products and registered retailers can be found at www.guamenergy.com or by calling the Guam Energy Office at **671-646-4361**. The appliance must be purchased in **Guam** on or after **December 06, 2010** and must be installed in a Guam residence. Voucher rebates will be given for the following qualifying products.:

Freezers - \$200

Refrigerators - \$200

Clothes washers - \$200

Room air conditioners - \$100

Split Air-Conditioners - \$200 – (or) \$350

Application Process

Prior to Purchase:

Applications can be picked up at the Guam Energy Office. Along with a completed and signed application, several supporting documents must be submitted to include: proper identification such as a Guam Drivers License, or Guam ID, three previous months utility bill that shows current installation address on Guam, a completed and signed Landlord/Tenant Certification Form, if applicable, and a completed and signed Consent to Release Utility Billing Information Form.
