**Relative to recognizing and honoring the courageous men and women of the Guam Police Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Police, and all federal law enforcement officers for their selfless service in the protection of life and property; and to further extending a warmhearted *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to them for their invaluable service to the island community, during the celebration of “Guam Police Week”, from May 15 to 21, 2011.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, “National Police Week” will be celebrated nationwide from May  
4 15 to 21, 2011, during which time the people of Guam will join in the celebration  
5 which gives a special tribute to the wonderful men and women of law enforcement  
6 who protect our nation’s numerous communities, and on the local front, our island  
7 community; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the courageous uniformed personnel of the Guam Police  
9 Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, the A.B. Won Pat International  
10 Airport Authority Police, and the federal law enforcement officers enforce the laws of  
11 our island every day, placing their lives at risk to serve and to protect our citizens; and

12           **WHEREAS**, with the constant increase of crimes being committed by  
13 individuals in our community annually, our police officers and law enforcement  
14 personnel continue to serve, despite the demand to work above and beyond designated  
15 work hours, sacrificing regularly their personal and family time for the welfare and  
16 safety of the community; and

17           **WHEREAS**, these brave men and women work daily with civilian personnel  
18 who perform critical functions in support of uniformed police officers, and whose  
19 efforts must continue to be recognized for their contribution to public safety; and

20           **WHEREAS**, many of Guam’s police, law enforcement personnel and peace  
21 officers have given the ultimate sacrifice of selflessness to the people of Guam, and  
22 have died in the line of duty, while serving their island community; and

23           **WHEREAS**, all men and women in uniform, (active, retired or past limited  
24 service) who have served as a police officer, law enforcement official, or peace officer

1 should be given special recognition and tribute for their individual and collective  
2 service to the people of Guam; and

3 **WHEREAS**, family members, including. parents, spouses, and children, of  
4 these police, law enforcement, and peace officers, should also be recognized for their  
5 indirect service to the island of Guam in providing the necessary support and  
6 encouragement to these men and women in uniform who serve and protect; now,  
7 therefore, be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*  
9 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
10 of Guam, recognize and commend the men and women of the Guam Police  
11 Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, the A.B. Won Pat International  
12 Airport Authority Police, and the federal law enforcement officers for their dedication,  
13 courage, and professionalism in their tremendous service to the people of Guam  
14 during the special celebration of “Guam Police Week”, from May 15 to 21, 2011; does  
15 encourage the entire island community to join in the celebration, and to participate  
16 with all law enforcement uniformed and civilian members, in the numerous programs  
17 designed to encourage the adherence to law, to promote public safety, and to pay  
18 tribute to the brave police officers and peace officers of Guam and across the nation  
19 who have given so much to the preservation of life and property through the fair and  
20 efficient enforcement of law; and does further extend a warmhearted *Un Dångkolo Na*  
21 *Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the men and women who continue to serve, or who have at one  
22 time served the community of Guam as a police, law enforcement, or peace officer, as  
23 well as to the men and women in the civilian community who provide direct or  
24 indirect support to these police officers; and to the spouses, children, parents, and

1 family members of police officers, for their selfless support of their loved ones as they  
2 serve and protect the people of Guam; and be it further

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on  
4 Rules certify and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that  
5 copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mr. Fred Bordallo, Chief of Police,  
6 Guam Police Department; to Ms. Doris Agüero, Chief, Port Authority of Guam  
7 Police; to Mr. Robert Camacho, Chief, A.B. Won Pat International Airport  
8 Authority Police; to the Administrators of the federal law enforcement agencies on  
9 Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J. B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
