Håfa Adai Mr. Rios,

Public Law 30-219, mandates that no later than fifteen (15) days after the end of the third quarter of each fiscal year, the Governor of Guam provide the Speaker of the Guam Legislature and the Office of Finance and Budget (OFB) a report of all correspondence with "the United States Treasury, the Department of Interior, the Office of Insular Affairs, or its successor, and any other entities of the United States Government related to prior and future fiscal year estimates and reconciliations of duties, fees, and taxes (also referred to as Section 30 funds) remitted prior to the commencement of the forthcoming fiscal year."

As the Chairman of the Committee on Appropriations (Committee) with oversight of the OFB, we have yet to receive any of the reports and documents required by law to be provided after requests have been made to your office.

Therefore I request the report and documents required by Public Law 30-219, pursuant to the authority granted in Section 10103 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, the "Freedom of Information Act."
