The matter before the Court is the parties' Stipulation regarding the accreditation status of the Latte Treatment Center (Guma Bethesda) group home. [Docket No. 847]. The Court has reviewed the Stipulation entered by the parties and filed on March 30, 2011 in the above-captioned case. On August 31, 2007, the parties had previously stipulated that:

Defendants affirm that it is their goal to become [Joint Commission for the Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations] JCAHO accredited, and to use JCAHO standards as a "measuring stick" for measuring Defendants' progress toward compliance with their obligation to meet minimum care standards. Plaintiffs agree that progress toward JCAHO


1 accreditation can be made incrementally, and that as each of
2 Defendants' programs or facilities achieve JCAHO
3 accreditation, that Program or facility will be deemed to have
4 met the minimum care requirements under the Amended
Permanent Injunction.

5 The August 31, 2007 Stipulation was approved by this Court on
6 November 27, 2007. [Docket No. 448]. On August 19, 2010, the Latte
7 Treatment Center (Guma Bethesda) group home was granted Behavioral Health
8 Accreditation status by the Joint Commission for the Accreditation of
9 Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO).

11 Upon consideration and for good cause showing, the Stipulation filed on
12 March 30, 2011 is **HEREBY APPROVED AND SO ORDERED**, but only
13 insofar as the Defendant's program under the Latte Treatment Center (Guma
14 Bethesda) group home is deemed to have met the minimum care requirements
15 under the Amended Permanent Injunction. The Latte Treatment Center (Guma
16 Bethesda) group home is hereby returned to the oversight of the Defendants so
17 long as that program maintains its accreditation from the JCAHO.
