This is to acknowledge receipt of your complaint. As you yourself are well aware, your complaint does not meet the elements of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan's* Standing Rules. Consequently, I am returning your complaint to you due to lack of legislative jurisdiction.

Specifically, under the Rules of Procedure for the Legislative Committee on Ethics and Standards, Rule 8 states the following:

"RULE 8: Form of Complaints

Complaints must be in writing and signed by the Complainant. Complaints and information about Senators and employees of the Legislature must be verified as true or that the complainant believes them to be true under threat of penalty and perjury under the Laws of Guam. Verification in the form or substantially similar to the Verification of Complaint form attached to these Rules shall be attached to a complaint. Complaints shall be made no later than July 2, 2012."
