MAGISTRATE'S COMPLAINT

The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO, and BYRON JAY RIVERA of certain crimes committed as follows:

FIRST CHARGE

Count One

On or about the period between March 1, 2013 and May 31, 2013, inclusive, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Uttam's Electronic Store* in *Tamuning*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at

1 a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to
2 so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

3 *Count Two*

4 On or about the period between March 1, 2013 and June 30, 2013, inclusive, in Guam, JUDE
5 RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the
6 property of *Uttam's Electronic Store* in *Tamuning*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at
7 a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to
8 so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

9 *Count Three*

10 On or about the period between March 1, 2013 and May 31, 2013, inclusive, *but at a time*
11 *different from other counts*, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense
12 of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Yamaha Store* in *Hagatña*, with the intent to commit
13 the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was
14 licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

15 *Count Four*

16 On or about July 8, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit
17 the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *TuRe's Café* in *Hagatña*, with the intent
18 to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor
19 Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

20 *Count Five*

21 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit
22 the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *MTB Outfitters* in *Hagatña*, with the
23 intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public
24 nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and
25 4.60.

26 *Count Six*

27 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit
28 the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *TuRe's Café* in *Hagatña*, with the intent

1 to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor
2 Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

3 *Count Seven*

4 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit
5 the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Guam Tropical Dive Station* in *Hagatña*,
6 with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the
7 public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b),
8 and 4.60.

9 *Count Eight*

10 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit
11 the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Standard Office Supply* in *Tamuning*, with
12 the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the
13 public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b),
14 and 4.60.

15 *Count Nine*

16 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit
17 the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Video Quest* in *Tamuning*, with the
18 intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public
19 nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and
20 4.60.

21 *Count Ten*

22 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit
23 the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Best American Tools* in *Tumon*, with the
24 intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public
25 nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and
26 4.60.

Count Eleven

On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *A1 Cycles in Tumon*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Twelve

On or about July 16, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Tei Jay Fish Mart in Barrigada*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Thirteen

On or about July 17, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Isla Home Infusion in Tamuning*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Fourteen

On or about July 17, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Cars Unlimited in Tamuning*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Fifteen

On or about July 17, 2013, in Guam, JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that he did enter in the property of *Shooterz in Hagatña*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendant was licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

1 SECOND CHARGE

2 On or about the period between March 1, 2013 and July 17, 2013, inclusive, in Guam, JUDE
3 RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA did commit the offense of *Theft of Property*, in that he did
4 unlawfully take, obtain or exercise unlawful control over the movable property of *another*, with intent
5 to deprive them thereof, the amount involved exceeding \$1,500.00, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 43.20(a)
6 and (f), 43.30(a), and 4.60.

7 THIRD CHARGE

8 *Count One*

9 On or about July 8, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY
10 RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting
11 in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to
12 enter in the property of *TuRe's Café* in *Hagatña*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at
13 a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged
14 to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

15 *Count Two*

16 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY
17 RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting
18 in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to
19 enter in the property of *MTB Outfitters* in *Hagatña*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein,
20 at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged
21 to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

22 *Count Three*

23 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY
24 RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting
25 in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to

15 *Count Six*

16 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY
17 RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting
18 in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to
19 enter in the property of *Video Quest* in *Tamuning*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein,
20 at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged
21 to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

22 *Count Seven*

23 On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY
24 RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting
25 in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to
26 enter in the property of *Best American Tools* in *Tumon*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft*
27 therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or
28 privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Eight

On or about July 15, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to enter in the property of *A1 Cycles* in *Tumon*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Nine

On or about July 16, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to enter in the property of *Tei Jay Fish Mart* in *Barrigada*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Ten

On or about July 17, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to enter in the property of *Isla Home Infusion* in *Tamuning*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

Count Eleven

On or about July 17, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to enter in the property of *Cars Unlimited* in *Tamuning*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.


On or about July 17, 2013, in Guam, RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY RIVERA did commit the offense of *Burglary*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting in the commission of *burglary*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to enter in the property of *Ecafe* in *Hagatña*, with the intent to commit the crime *theft* therein, at a time when the premises was neither open to the public nor Defendants were licensed or privileged to so enter in, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 37.20(a), (b), and 4.60.

FOURTH CHARGE

On or about the period between July 8, 2013 and July 17, 2013, inclusive, in Guam RONNIE JUNIOR CRISOSTOMO and BYRON JAY RIVERA did commit the offense of *Theft of Property*, in that, with the intention of promoting or assisting in the commission of *theft*, they induced or aided JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA to unlawfully take, obtain or exercise unlawful control over the movable property of *another*, with intent to deprive them thereof, the amount involved exceeding \$500.00 but not more than \$1,500.00, in violation of 9 GCA §§ 43.20(b) and (f), 43.30(a), and 4.60.

DECLARATION

COMES NOW, GABRIELLE ROSSI, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, and aver, upon information and belief, that the following is true.

I have reviewed Guam Police Report Nos. 13-20397, 13-20398, 13-20409, and 13-20476 submitted by GPD Officer Terlaje (#761) and others, which sets forth, that the following events occurred on Guam.

Between the dates of March 2013 to May 2013, the Uttam's Electronic Store in Tamuning was burglarized. Jason Fegurgur drove his step-brother **JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA** ("Jude") to Uttam's. Jude used a crowbar to pry open a wooden window cover to the building. Jude then entered through the window and took electronics and less than \$100.00 US currency.

Between the dates of March 2013 to June 2013, Jacob Fegurgur drove his step-brother **JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA** ("Jude") to the Uttam's Electronic Store in Tamuning so Jude could burglarize the establishment a second time. While Jacob acted as look-out, Jude entered through a second-floor window and took electronics and less than \$100.00 US currency.

Between the dates of March 2013 to June 2013, two weeks after the second Uttam's burglary, the Yamaha Store in Hagatna was burglarized. Jason Fegurgur drove his step-brother **JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA** ("Jude") to the Yamaha store. Jude entered through a side window. While inside the store, Jude accidentally set off an alarm. No items were taken as a result of Jude setting off the alarm.

On or about July 8, 2013, the Tu Re's Cafe in Hagatna was burglarized. **JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA** ("Jude"), **R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996)** ("R.J.C."), and **B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997)** ("B.J.R."), drove to Tu Re's using another minor's vehicle. Jude broke a window with a hammer and entered the establishment while R.J.C. waited outside to act as look-out. Jude took approximately \$400.00 in US currency from the cash register. All five individuals split the proceeds of the burglary.

On or about July 15, 2013, the MTB Outfitters in Hagatna was burglarized. **JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA** ("Jude"), **R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996)** ("R.J.C."), **B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997)** ("B.J.R."), drove to MTB Outfitters in the early morning hours. R.J.C. and Jude broke the front glass door

while B.J.R. remained in the vehicle as a getaway driver. Jude and R.J.C. took approximately \$100.00 in US currency. All three individuals split the proceeds of the burglary.

On or about July 15, 2013, the Tu Re's Cafe in Hagatna was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to Standard Office Supply. R.J.C. broke a window and entered the establishment while Jude waited outside to act as look-out. R.J.C. took a laptop and \$3.00 in US currency from Tu Re's.

On or about July 15, 2013, the Guam Tropical Dive Station in Hagatna was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to the store in R.J.C.'s van. R.J.C. broke a side window and entered the establishment with Jude while B.J.R. waited outside to act as look-out. R.J.C. took a cash register, which contained approximately \$150.00 in US currency. All three individuals split the proceeds amongst themselves and two other minors.

On or about July 15, 2013, the Standard Office Supply in Tamuning was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996), ("R.J.C.") B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R.") drove to Standard Office Supply. R.J.C. broke a window with a hammer. Jude entered the establishment while R.J.C. waited outside to act as look-out. Jude took the cash register, which contained approximately \$100.00 in US currency from the cash register. All three individuals split the proceeds of the burglary.

On or about July 15, 2013, the Video Quest in Tamuning was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to Video Quest. Jude broke a window with a hammer and entered the establishment while R.J.C. and B.J.R. waited in the car. Jude took approximately \$100.00 in US currency from the cash register. All three individuals split the proceeds of the burglary.

On or about July 15, 2013, the Best American Tools in Tumon was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to the store in R.J.C.'s van. All three burglarized the establishment. Nothing of significant value was known to have been taken from the store at the time of filing.

On or about July 15, 2013, the A1 Cycles in Tumon was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to the store in R.J.C.'s van. R.J.C. broke the front window and Jude went inside to take

whatever he could find of value. B.J.R. and two other minors acted as look-outs. **Nothing of significant value was known to have been taken from the store at the time of filing.**

On or about **July 16, 2013**, the **Tei Jay Fish Mart** in Barrigada was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to the business in Jude's father's Nissan pickup truck. R.J.C. broke the front glass door. R.J.C. entered the establishment while Jude and B.J.R. waited outside to act as look-outs. **Nothing of significant value was known to have been taken from the store at the time of filing.**

On or about **July 17, 2013**, the **Isla Home Infusion** in Tamuning was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to the business in the stolen vehicle. R.J.C. broke a front window with a tire iron and entered the establishment while Jude and B.J.R. waited outside to act as look-outs. R.J.C. set off the alarm, whereby he ran out and escaped with his cohorts without taking anything. **Nothing of significant value was known to have been taken from the store at the time of filing.**

On or about **July 17, 2013**, the **Cars Unlimited** in Tamuning was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude"), R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C."), B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R."), drove to the business in the stolen vehicle. Jude broke a front window and entered the establishment while R.J.C. and B.J.R. waited in the Denny's parking lot and acted as look-outs. Jude took **\$500.00 in US currency.**

On or about **July 17, 2013**, shortly after the burglary of the Cars Unlimited, the **Shooterz** in Hagatna was burglarized. JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA ("Jude") broke a front window with a tire iron and entered the establishment while R.J.C. and B.J.R. burglarized the ECafe next door. Jude took **\$3.00 in US currency** from the tip jar.

On or about **July 17, 2013**, shortly after the burglary of the Cars Unlimited, the **ECafe** in Hagatna was burglarized. R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996) ("R.J.C.") and B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997) ("B.J.R.") drove to the business in the stolen vehicle. R.J.C. and B.J.R. broke a window and entered the establishment while Jude burglarized the Shooterz next door. **Nothing of significant value was known to have been taken from the store at the time of filing.**

The total value of the US currency stolen by JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA as part of burglaries committed either alone or as part of a group is **\$1,656.00.**

The total value of the US currency stolen by **R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996)** and **B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997)** is **\$1,453.00**

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **JUDE RYAN CRISOSTOMO QUENGA** with **fifteen counts** of **BURGLARY** (As Second Degree Felonies) in violation of Title 9 G. C. A. § 37.20(a) and (b) and § 4.60; and **THEFT OF PROPERTY** (As a Second Degree Felony) in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. § 43.20(a) and (f), § 43.30(a), and § 4.60.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge **R.J.C. (DOB: 8/1/1996)** and **B.J.R. (DOB: 11/1/1997)** with **twelve counts** of **BURGLARY** (As Second Degree Felonies) in violation of Title 9 G. C. A. § 37.20(a) and (b) and §4.60; and **THEFT OF PROPERTY** (As a Third Degree Felony) in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. § 43.20(b) and (f), § 43.30(a), and § 4.60.
