In addition, the Club has made numerous donations, such as cleaning supplies, toiletries, and miscellaneous equipment to various Senior Citizens Centers, the Catholic Social Service Day Care for Seniors, the Skilled Nursing Facility, the Yigo Dementia Center for Senior Citizens, Guma San Jose Homeless Shelter, and the St. Dominic Nursing Home.

The Guam Sunshine Lions Club, having spearheaded a major project to purchase a \$90,000 wheelchair-lift para transit bus for the elderly and individuals with disabilities at the Catholic Social Services Adult Care Center, delivered the vehicle on December 10, 2016. A third of the cost was provided by the Sunshine Lions Club through raffle ticket sales, with assistance from the: Guam Latte Stone Lions Club, Guam Galaide Lions Club, Guam Stars Lions Club, Agat Guamerica Lions Club, Guahan Ayudante Lions Club, Guam Spirit Lions Club, Guam Gadao Lions Club, Guam Guahan Lions Club, and Guam Marianas Lions Club; one third from the Lions Club International Foundation through a matching grant, and one third from the Catholic Social Services. Guam Sunshine Lion Danny Cruz, currently 2nd Vice-District Governor, coordinated and managed the project.

According to Lion Theresa "Ewy" Taitano, Club President, "The success and continuation of any club is dependent on all the contributions of its members. We are certainly proud of our club's 20 years of service to the community. Also, special appreciation goes to our donors who have embraced and supported the work that we do by their contributions to our various fundraisers throughout these 20 years.
