18 The Attorney General of Guam hereby accuses **EDDIE CRUZ TAITANO** of certain crimes

21 **FIRST CHARGE**

22 On or about the 24th day of May, 2012, in Guam, **EDDIE CRUZ TAITANO** did commit the
23 offense of *Possession of Schedule II Controlled Substance*, in that he unlawfully and knowingly
24 possessed a Schedule II controlled substance, that is, an amphetamine-based substance, in violation
25 of 9 GCA §§ 67.401.2(a) and (b)(1).



SECOND CHARGE

On or about the 24th day of May, 2012, in Guam, **EDDIE CRUZ TAITANO** did commit the offense of *Criminal Trespass*, when, knowing that he was not licensed or privileged to do so, he did enter and remain in a place to which notice against trespass was given by fencing or other enclosure manifestly designed to exclude intruders, in violation of 9 GCA § 37.30(b)(3), as amended.

DECLARATION

COMES NOW, BROOKE E. WRIGHT, a duly appointed Assistant Attorney General, and aver, upon information and belief, that the following is true.

I have reviewed Guam Port Police Report No. 12-0033 (Guam Police Department Report No. 12-6337) submitted by Port Authority Police Officer J.A. Sandlin, and others, which sets forth the following events occurred on Guam:

On or about 1:10 p.m. on May 24, 2012, Guam Port Police Officer Sandlin was posted at the container checkpoint when he noticed a black pickup truck traveling through the gate and entering the port. The vehicle was located at "Lower Tower" and the operator was identified as EDDIE CRUZ TAITANO. A plastic straw was located in the bed of the truck, and inside the truck a marker was found which concealed three small plastic bags. The straw was field tested and yielded a positive result for methamphetamines.

Based on the foregoing, there is probable cause to charge EDDIE CRUZ TAITANO with One (1) Count of POSSESSION OF A SCHEDULE II CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, as a THIRD DEGREE FELONY, in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. §67.401.2 (a) and (b)(1); and One (1) Count of CRIMINAL TRESPASS, as a VIOLATION, in violation of Title 9 G.C.A. §37.30(b)(3).

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
